Engaging Activities about Spring!

(Week of 3/30-4/3)

Arts/Crafts:

Materials:

Paper towel
Water colors
Pipe cleaners or straws
Twist tie
Googly eyes (if you have them)



Instructions:

For the twist tie and pipe cleaner butterflies, simply wrap your twist tie or pipe cleaner around the middle of the wings, twist to secure, and shape the antennae. For the bendy-straw butterfly, stick the straws together with some tape or hot glue, and use a twist tie to secure the wings to the straws. Kids love to cook and measure ingredients follow this recipe to make Finger Paint.

DIY Homemade Finger Paint:

2 tablespoons sugar1/3 cup cornstarch2 cups cold water1/4 cup clear liquid dish soapfood coloring or food coloring paste



<u>Instructions:</u> Mix together sugar and cornstarch in a small pan, then slowly add cold water. Cook over low heat, stirring until the mixture becomes a smooth; almost clear gel about 5 minutes.

When it's cool, stir in clear dishwashing liquid.

Scoop equal amounts of the mixture into containers and stir in food coloring or, for even more vibrant colors, use food-coloring paste.
