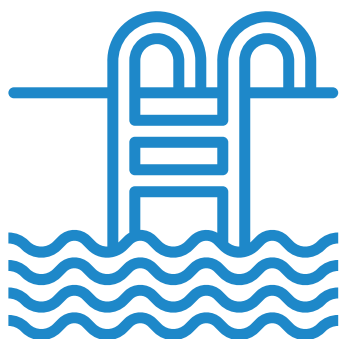

OUTDOOR POOL WEATHER POLICY

In order for the Outdoor Pool to remain open, we must be able to keep a clear path, free of ice and snow, from the locker rooms to the pool. Due to the hazard of ice forming if the ambient temperature is 32° or below, the wind chill is below 25° the outdoor pool will be closed as a safety precaution.

OUTDOOR POOL CLOSURE CONDITIONS INCLUDE:

- Outside temperature is 32 or below degrees F° or the ambient/wind chill temperature is below 25 degrees F°. (as stated by weather.gov)
- The deck (immediately next to the pool) and emergency exits are unable to be cleared of snow and ice.
- Fog, steam, snow, sleet and freezing rain above the water line prevent staff from clearly viewing the swimmers in any area of the pool.
- If the licensed Operator, Director or Inspector determines general unsafe conditions exists.

If the pool closes due any of the prior stated reasons all outdoor pool reservations will be canceled.
