Are you looking for 5 minutes of fame? Sign up for your YMCA Idol Debut at THINGAMAJIG®!



- **Fruit:** apples, pears, bananas, strawberries, blueberries, blackberries, pineapple, tomatoes, avocados
- **Vegetables:** kale, collards, potatoes, sweet potatoes, broccoli, corn, peppers, carrots, celery
