Retreat Center Group Rentals

YMCA Camp Letts is an idyllic multi-purpose rental venue set on the banks of the Rhode River just one mile from the Chesapeake Bay and 30 miles outside of Washington DC. Our facilities are available for rental September – May for group reservations of all shapes and sizes.

Booking Procedures & Payments

A signed contract and 10% non-refundable deposit are required to fully confirm all reservations. Camp Letts will hold lodges and meeting spaces for no more than 14 days without a signed contract and deposit. Activities are subject to availability and are booked on a first-come-first-serve basis. Any special requests must be in writing and come from the group leader. Please note that the contract specifies lodging, meals and any add on activities.

Payment in full is due one week prior to your visit. Reservations are not guaranteed without a signed contract AND deposit. The deposit is NON-REFUNDABLE.

Guaranteed Minimum Guest Count

Camp Letts charges per person for all overnight and daily guests. The guaranteed minimum guest count is the minimum number of guests for which camp will prepare and for which the group is required to pay. Guaranteed minimum guest counts are due 30 days prior to your visit. Any changes in the guaranteed minimum must be made in writing.

Changes in the guaranteed minimum guest count can be made up to 4 weeks prior to a group's arrival. After that date, the group is required to pay for no fewer guests than the guaranteed minimum. The group's final head count (if exceeding the guaranteed minimum #) is due 2 weeks prior to the event.

Certificate of Insurance / Event Insurance

Every group, large and small, must provide a Certificate of Insurance naming YMCA Camp Letts as an additionally insured, for the amount of \$1,000,000 per incident. This must be provided at least two weeks before your group's arrival to camp.

If alcohol is being served, the group must obtain and provide a liquor license from Anne Arundel County at: aacounty.org/liquorboard

Cancellation Policy

After the contract has been signed by both parties, the group is responsible for full payment for cancellations occurring within 8 weeks prior to reservation arrival date. All notifications of cancellations are required in writing. Once on site, if the group chooses to leave YMCA Camp Letts prior to the agreed upon departure time and date, no refund will be given and the payment of the full contract and all activity fees are due.

Meeting Spaces

Camp Letts has 3 meeting spaces on site, small and large, up to 300. One meeting space is included with any overnight-with-meals reservation for 50 guests or more. Groups smaller than 50 guests must rent a meeting space. See "Retreat Group Space Rental" in this brochure for more information.

Camp Activities

Camp Letts offers traditional camp activities, led by Camp Letts staff. Many of Camp Letts' activities are weather dependent. Closing program areas will be at the discretion of the Camp Letts staff. In case of inclement weather, other programs will not be substituted. It is the responsibility of the group to plan and facilitate a "Plan B" in the event Camp Letts scheduled activities must be canceled due to weather. The group leader will be informed in the event of cancelation.

Cabin Accommodations and What to Bring

All beds are bunk style with attached bathrooms. Guests will need to bring a sleeping bag or twin size sheets and blanket, a pillow, towels and toiletries. We recommend guests bring clothes appropriate to the season. See "Suggested Packing List" in this brochure for more information on what to bring. Guests will need closed toe and heel shoes for zip line, and the team development courses. Camp Letts facilities are heated. The only facilities with air conditioning are the Dining Hall, Fisher Hall, Boathouse and Letts Lodge.

Dining Facilities & Food Services

Camp Letts has a large dining hall space that can accommodate up to 300 sitting guests. Overnight groups may rent exclusive use of the dining hall, for use outside of meal times during your visit. Day groups may rent the dining hall for ½ day or full day programs. See the "Retreat Group Space Rental" page.

Groups may find themselves sharing the dining space during meals. Camp Letts can provide meal services for groups of 50 or more. Groups of less than 50 or those who do not choose to contract food services through Camp Letts may bring in their own food, own catering services, or order local food delivery services.

Liquor License Requirement

The possession or use of alcohol by any group is prohibited unless the group has secured a liquor license from Anne Arundel County. The liquor license must be submitted to Camp Letts prior to the event so it can be posted during the event. The group may only consume their beverages in their designated area. The possession or use of illegal drugs by any group or group member is strictly prohibited at YMCA Camp Letts. Violators will be reported to local authorities. A license may be obtained by going to aacounty.org/liquorboard

First Aid While On-Site

- Rental groups are responsible for providing their own First Aid, First Aid Supplies, Emergency Care, and Emergency Transportation for their participants and leaders.
- If rental groups need a locked space to store medications and first aid supplies, please contact the Retreat Director directly to coordinate. Letts advises rental groups to store all medications (prescription and over-the-counter) under lock except when in the controlled possession of the person responsible for administering them.
- Letts advises that rental groups obtain information regarding known allergies and health conditions that require treatment, restriction, or other accommodations while on-site.

Supervision While On-Site

- It is the rental group's responsibility to supervise the group's participants and behavior while on-site.
- Letts highly advises that all rental groups have 1 or more of their staff on-site with a current CPR/AED and First Aid certification during the duration of their booking.
- It is the rental group's responsibility to supervise and lead Self-Guided Activities.
- All staff members of the rental group(s) are at least sixteen (16) years of age and at least two (2) years older than the minor with whom they are working.
- The ratios of staff of the rental group(s) who are on duty and supervising campers in units or living areas during unstructured time and in general camp activities should meet the following minimums:

Zip Line

Description: Climb 20 feet into the air and then soar down our 250 feet of zip line through our scenic woodlands. This is a great and exhilarating way to enjoy the natural beauty at camp.

Canoeing

Description: Share a boat with a few of your friends as you paddle along the Rhode River. Learn the basic strokes of canoeing as you navigate the waters surrounding Camp Letts.

Cost: \$300 for a 60-minute session

Ages and Group Size: All ages. 4th grade and under should have 1 adult per canoe; maximum of 25 people

Skills & Values: YMCA Core Values (Caring, Honest, Respect, Responsibility), Recreation, Adventure, Perseverance, Skill Development, Leadership, Team Building, Cooperation, Communication, Problem Solving, Independence

Nature Hike - Self Guided

Description: Explore the coastline and discover the plants, animals, and landscape of Camp Letts. A trail map is provided.

Ages and Group Size: All ages; maximum of 25 people per session

Courts and Field Sports – Self Guided

Description: Take in a little exercise, sunshine and fresh air while discovering the treasures of the Chesapeake Bay! A sports shed is provided with an array of supplies, including, but not limited to: basketball, volleyball, tennis, gaga ball.

Ages and Group Size: All ages. All sizes.

Camp Fire – Self Guided

Description: Camp Letts staff will prepare your fire pit so it is lighter ready when your group is ready to enjoy. Pick from 4 available fire circles or enjoy a portable pit. S'more sticks can be available upon request. A bucket of water is also provided for safe extinguishing. <u>Actual S'more supplies not included, bring your own s'mores.</u>

Cost: \$25 for wood and set up. Please bring your own lighter.
